Former Congressman **Martin Frost** is a keen analyst of politics and policy in Washington, D.C. He served as a member of Congress from 1979 - 2005, representing the Dallas-Fort

Worth area in north Texas. Frost held a number of leadership positions in the U.S. House of Representatives. He was the Ranking Member of the Committee on Rules, he served on the House Budget Committee and chaired the Health Task Force. He also served as Chair of the Caucus. When Frost departed Congress, he was the dean of the Texas Congressional delegation.



Former Congressman **Kenny Hulshof** has established a strong national reputation as a leader with integrity. For 12 years (1997-2009) he served with distinction in the U.S. House of Representatives, representing Missouri's Ninth Congressional District. Hulshof was appointed by former Speaker of the House Newt Gingrich to the powerful Ways and Means Committee. Hulshof served on this prestigious committee during his entire congressional tenure and was a member of the Health and Trade subcommittees. He also served with distinction on the House Committee on Standards of Official Conduct and the Budget Committee.
